PURPOSE:

To deliver the responsibility of a controlling body to ensure that netball at all levels is conducted in accordance with sporting and disciplined behaviour as required in the introduction section of the international rules of netball.

PROCESSES:

This responsibility is achieved by a combination of initiatives described in the Regulations and operational procedures. These include:

- Emphasising/reminding team players and coaches of their responsibilities outlined in the international rules book at the time of registration of teams
- Training and coaching of umpires in game management techniques by the umpire coaches
- Collation of records of player warnings and suspensions; meetings with and actions for repeat 'offenders'
- Observations of unfair play by umpire coaches reported to Centre manager for corrective discussions/action
- The complaints process
- Judicial committee process
- Team Fair Play awards (TBC)
