UMPIRES CODE OF CONDUCT

- Positively perform and comply with all duties and obligations of an umpire in the rules of netball
- Support other umpires and do not openly criticise their decisions; work constructively with other umpires and utilise the umpire coaches to improve their skills
- Be a positive role model on and off the court, both in behaviour and personal appearance, and act with courtesy and consideration towards all those with whom you come into contact
- Receive rule clarifications professionally and respond courteously and constructively without being defensive
- Report any abuse to TNC
- When at netball in another capacity (eg playing, coaching) you are always bound by this code of conduct

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Play according to the rules of netball and the principles of fair play
- Never argue with an umpire or criticise the decisions of an umpire. If you are concerned talk to your coach
- Treat all players with respect.
- Verbal abuse or deliberate contact is unacceptable
- Appreciate and cooperate with your coach, teammates and officials.
- Take responsibility for your performance and actions on and off the court.

- Positively model and operate within the rules of the netball and in the spirit of fair play, while encouraging your players to do the same.
- Be a positive role model for players: display control, respect, dignity and professionalism to all involved with the sport.
- Refrain from open criticism of umpires' decisions, and of other coaches, players and your Netball Centre: raise any concerns through TNC official channels.
- Report any form of abuse towards players or team officials whilst in your care to TNC

PARENTS, CAREGIVERS AND SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Encourage players to play to the rules of the game and respect umpires' decisions
- Support the removal of verbal and physical abuse from the game
- Do not criticise an umpire's decisions or make comments about the umpiring. Follow the TNC guidelines if you have any issues or concerns.
- Teach players that effort is as important as victory, so that the result of each game is accepted without undue disappointment.
- Remember players are involved in netball for their enjoyment not yours.
- Recognise and value the importance of coaches and other volunteers who give their time and resources to provide netball
- Applaud good play by players on both teams
- Keep back from the side-lines and allow the umpire space to move around the outside of the court
- Model positive feedback to players and do not move up and down the sidelines during the game.

UMPIRE COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

- Positively model and operate within the NNZ Community Umpiring Guidelines
- Support each umpire in reaching their individual goals
- Be supportive, courteous and respectful and open to discussion
- Co-operate with the lead umpire coaches and other umpire coaches to coordinate coaching activities and work as a team
- When conducting one on one coaching sessions ensure you are within the sight of at least one TNC third party
- Do not openly criticise other umpire coaches or officials.
- Comply with the Umpires Code of Conduct
