Qualifying Tournament

To ensure our Premier competition remains competitive, a qualifying tournament will be held to determine the 18 teams for the current season. All teams from our 2024 Premier Competition will have right of entry into the qualifying tournament.

The Qualifying Tournament is scheduled for Saturday 22nd March at Mercury Arena (draws to be confirmed). The fee for this day has been included in your overall fee. Team Registrations are due Friday 21st February – no late registrations will be accepted.

The date of the first Premier game will be Thursday 8th May 2025

Please note: The unsuccessful teams who do not gain one of the 18 spots available in the Premier Club Competition will have the opportunity to move to Wednesday nights. There will be grading on <u>Wednesday 26th March</u> to determine what grade they will go in, in the Senior Club Competition on Wednesday evenings unless otherwise advised. These teams will be refunded \$1075 (Baypark fee and \$160 of umpire fee). For teams who do not wish to be included in the Wednesday Comp, this will need to be communicated to Tauranga Netball Centre management prior to the qualifying tournament. Any excess of fees will be refunded.

Competition Format

Following the qualifying tournament teams will be placed in 3 divisions of 6. Each team will play 5 games in a round over 2 rounds and a Semi and Final. Teams may be moved up or down following each round at Managements discretion depending on obvious score gaps. Please note that if Centre Management identifies a cause to move a team up or down who have not fallen within these perimeters this will be at Managements discretion. Teams will be notified.

Umpires

As in 2024, Umpires will be provided for this competition and the Centre will pay this fee to Umpires directly. The umpire fee is included in the total invoice.

It is of growing concern to the TNC Umpire Group, that our Clubs are not developing umpires who they can provide to umpire their teams in other competitions. The TNC Umpires Group are providing LTU Workshops, and Umpire Coaching for your Club members, supporters, ex or current players (includes Premier players or Club members), etc to learn to umpire, who can then be available for your Clubs and to the TNC Netball Centre to umpire the competitions that your Club teams are required to supply Umpires for in the future. **Succession planning is essential for all Clubs (Club Premier teams included) and this includes your umpires**. All of our Umpires who umpire for the Premier Club Competition are on the "Umpires Pathway" and are growing and developing their skills at each of their qualification that they hold. The minimum qualification for umpires in this competition is to hold a Centre Practical with Zone Theory or above qualification.

Umpires will be allocated to teams' games as per their qualifications and skills shown appropriate for each grade. All of our Umpires are being actively coached and viewed to make sure the skills they display are suitable for the game they are on. We want to remind everyone that any verbal confrontations from players, coaches, spectators, or supporters towards the umpires are unacceptable and will not be tolerated. It is the player's responsibility to play within the rules and to accept the umpire decisions and adapt their gameplay accordingly.

With the implementation of the 2024 Netball rules, there is a strong emphasis on player safety and the importance of abiding by the Rules to avoid any Game Management decisions from Umpires.

Only the team captains and or any player concerned are permitted to approach the umpire for clarification of a rule during the intervals.

Technical Officials

All teams must have at least 2 trained score bench people. 1 of these people must be available to attend each game on the score bench to represent their team each week. These people must be available for bench duty on the day of the Qualifying Tournament. Training will take place on grading day prior to tournament start, time will be advised closer to the time. Teams will need to advise Tracy <u>manager@tauranganetball.co.nz</u> if a representative will be attending the training. Please ensure any representative on the score bench are happy to communicate with TNC staff and open to training and feedback.

Umpires

Each team is required to provide an Umpire with a <u>minimum qualification of a</u> <u>current NZ Zone Award</u>, and must be named on your team list, any changes to your Umpires during the season, must be advised to the TNC Umpire Lead at <u>umpirelead@tauranganetball.co.nz as soon as possible</u>. It is important that an Umpire is suitably qualified for this grade and is capable of moving with the game which will require a good standard of fitness. **Please make sure your Umpire is committed to Umpire for your team for the season**.

For Umpire Coaching purposes your Umpire can **register as either as a** "Development Pathway" Umpire or a "Continuing Pathway" Umpire at our Centre to receive coaching from the relevant Umpire Coach Panel for their development.

Your team Umpire will form the pool of Umpires for this competition and will be allocated to games as per their qualifications and skills shown, the Centre will pay the Umpires directly from the Umpires fee which is included in your fees.

We want to remind everyone that any verbal confrontations from players, coaches, spectators, or supporters towards the umpires are unacceptable and will not be tolerated. It is the player's responsibility to play within the rules and to accept the umpire decisions and adapt their gameplay accordingly.

With the implementation of the 2024 Netball rules, there is a strong emphasis on player safety and the importance of abiding by the Rules to avoid any Game Management decisions from Umpires.

Only the team captains and or any player concerned are permitted to approach the umpire for clarification of a rule during the intervals.

Technical Officials

All teams must have at least 2 trained score bench people. 1 of these people must be available to attend each game on the score bench to represent their team each week. These people must be available for bench duty on the day of the Qualifying Tournament. Training will take place on grading day prior to tournament start, time will be advised closer to the time. Teams will need to advise Tracy <u>manager@tauranganetball.co.nz</u> if a representative will be attending the training. Please ensure any representative on the score bench are happy to communicate with TNC staff and open to training and feedback.

Senior Club Competition (Wednesday)

The process for existing teams to register will be to log in, click on team name, click on join competition in green box, choose division, click join and update your team details. PLEASE ENSURE ALL PLAYERS, TEAM MANAGERS, COACHES AND UMPIRES HAVE CORRECT EMAILS AND MOBILE NUMBERS, IF THIS IS NOT ADHERED TO YOUR TEAM MAY LOSE POINTS. WE HAD A NUMBER OF INCIDENTS LAST SEASON WHERE TEAMS DID NOT HAVE CORRECT DETAILS ENTERED, THE RESULT BEING TEAMS WERE NOT INFORMED OF CANCELLATIONS ETC. AND IMPORTANT INFORMATION WAS NOT BEING RECEIVED.

Team Registrations

Registrations are due by <u>Wednesday 5th February 2025.</u> Incomplete registrations that have not been approved by this date will not be considered. Players names do not need to be entered until Wednesday 4th March. <u>All teams must register the</u> <u>required number of Umpires (see ratio below) along with their team by the 5th</u> <u>February otherwise the team registration will NOT be accepted</u>. This Umpire must have a qualification of <u>NZ Centre Award</u> or above. The TNC Umpire Lead will allocate these Umpires and will pay them directly.

These Umpires will form the <u>Umpires Pool</u> and be allocated to games/grades as per their qualification, experience, and skills displayed.

Grading

Grading will be held over 3 weeks (we have removed the one-day grading). Teams will be put in pools of 4 and will play 1 game per grading night. First grading night is **Wednesday 5th March 2025**, next grading is **Wednesday 12th March** and last grading night is **Wednesday 19th March 2025**.

Premier Grading is held on Saturday 22nd March – the 6 teams that do not qualify for Prems will have an opportunity to move to the Wednesday comp. There will be a grading on **Wednesday 26th March** to determine what grade they will go in. Teams in Grades 2 – 8 will not play on this day. Dependent on how many teams transfer over will determine who from Grade 1 will play off to help us gage better who should be in Grade 1 and will move down to Grade 2 which will then impact on teams below. Teams who will grade against the Premier teams moving down will be charged an extra fee of \$40 to pay the umpires.

Competition Format

The Senior Club Competition will commence on **Wednesday 2nd April 2025** and will be played outdoors at Tauranga Netball Centre for 12 weeks (not consecutive). Depending on the number of teams that register will determine how many grades there will be. Pools 1 – 4 will be competitive and pools 5 – 8 social. A maximum of six teams per grade, two round robins, semis and finals. All 1st placings will move up and all 6th placings will move down after each round. At the commencement of the 2 rounds we will have semi-finals on **Wednesday 25th June** and Finals **on Wednesday 16th July** (subject to change if we have postponements during the season).

Game times are 6.30pm and 7.30pm. Playing 4 x 12 minute quarters with 2 minutes at the quarter and half time breaks. Playing Dates are:

Umpires

Every team is required to provide Umpires with a <u>minimum qualification of a current</u> <u>NZ Centre Award</u>, your Umpires must be named on your team list, any changes to your Umpires during the season, must be advised to the TNC Umpire Lead at <u>umpirelead@tauranganetball.co.nz as soon as possible</u>. It is important that an Umpire is suitably qualified for the grade they are umpiring and is capable of moving with the game which will require a certain standard of fitness.

All Umpires must be on the Umpire's Pathway, **be registered as either as a** "Development Pathway" Umpire or a "Continuing Pathway" Umpire and be responsive to umpire development and coaching. Umpires need to understand their commitment to umpire for the Senior competition on Wednesday nights.

If you have a member of your Club or other person willing to Umpire for your team/s who doesn't already have an umpire qualification, we will allow your Umpire to be developed to become a qualified Umpire during the current season. Your proposed Umpire must attend an "LTU – Learn to Umpire" workshop, sit the NNZ Learning to Umpire Module and be open to being coached by the Centre Umpire Coaching Panel towards gaining their NZ Centre Award before the season ends.

It is a continuing concern to the TNC Umpire Group, that a lot of our Clubs are not developing Umpires who they can provide to umpire their teams. The TNC Umpires Group are providing LTU Workshops, and Umpire Coaching for your club members, supporters, ex or current players, to learn to umpire, and also for your already qualified Umpires to develop, who can then be available for your Clubs and to the TNC Netball Centre to umpire your competitions for your teams in the future. **Succession planning is essential for all Clubs, and this includes your umpires**.

Teams will need to provide the required number of Umpires who will either be at least a NZ Centre Award qualified Umpire or who will attend one of the LTU workshops on offer in 2025 (see page 15). Below is the expected ratio for Umpires against teams:

1 team – provide 2 umpires 2 teams – provide 3 umpires 3 teams – provide 4 umpires 4 teams – provide 6 umpires 5 teams – provide 7 umpires

The teams named Umpires will form a pool of Umpires for this competition and will be allocated to the competition games each week from this pool. It is the responsibility of the teams to fulfil this requirement **every week**. All **umpires will be paid monthly for games umpired by TNC directly**.

We want to remind everyone that any verbal confrontations from players, coaches, spectators, or supporters towards the Umpires are unacceptable and will not be tolerated. It is the player's responsibility to play within the rules and to accept the umpire decisions and adapt their gameplay accordingly.

With the implementation of the 2024 Netball rules, there is a strong emphasis on player safety and the importance of abiding by the Rules to avoid any Game Management decisions from Umpires.

Only the team captains and/or any player concerned are permitted to approach the Umpires for clarification of a rule during the intervals.

Cancellations

A cancellation decision will be made on the day **at 4.30pm** and uploaded to the website and Facebook page. Team Managers and Convenors will automatically be advised via email. Cancellations will only take place if weather is deemed too unsafe to play. We will not necessarily cancel for rain and wind conditions.

Club/Team Netball Convenor

Each club/team must designate one person to act as their Netball Convenor to liaise with the centre. The convenor must keep in regular contact with the centre, must submit **all team registrations** by the due date and notify the centre of any changes (adding/deleting players), in fact everything and anything pertaining to your club/team.

College Players

College players will only be allowed to play in 2 of the following leagues (this requirement is to align to the balance is better principles and netball smart directives).

• College Netball (Friday night)

- College Club Netball (Wednesday night)
- Premier College Club Netball (Thursday night)
- Senior Netball (Wednesday night)
- Senior Premier Netball (Thursday night)

Masters Grade (Thursday night)

There will be 12 teams in this competition and it will run for 9 weeks with the starting date of **Thursday 13th February 2025** playing alternating rounds with the Mixed grade at Baypark. Round times will alternate between 6pm, 7pm and 8pm. Dates are 13th, 20th, 27th, February, 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th March and 3rd, 10th April. Players must be 35 or over and you will be allowed to register up to 15 players. For more information contact Tracy manager@tauranganetball.co.nz

Mixed Grade (Thursday night)

There will be 7 teams in this competition and it will run for 9 weeks with the starting date of **Thursday 13th February 2025** playing alternating rounds with the Masters grade at Baypark. Round times will alternate between 6pm, 7pm and 8pm. Dates are 13th, 20th, 27th, February, 6th, 13th, 20th, 27th March and 3rd, 10th April. Players must be Year 11 or over. Junior Club Grade (Wednesday night)

Grades will be U11 (must be Year 6), U13, U15 and U18 – players must be this age or under as at 1st January 2025 to be eligible for the appropriate age group. This competition will run for 7 weeks with the starting date of **Wednesday 5th March 2025**. Game will be at 6.30pm every Wednesday. Dates are 15th, 12th, 19th, 26th March and 2nd, 9th, 30th April. Registrations are due 5th February 2025 but players do not have to be entered until 4th March 2025. U11 and U13 teams can have 3 male players on the court and U15 and U18 teams can have 1 male player on the court and all teams are to supply their own umpire which TNC will allocate. Junior Premier Club Grade (Thursday night)

Games will be at 4.45pm every Thursday at Baypark. Dates are 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th May, 5th, 12th, 19th, 26th June, 17th, 31st July and 7th, 14th August. Registrations are due **11th April 2025** but players do not have to be entered until **7th May 2025**. 1 male player is allowed on the court and all teams are to supply their own umpire which TNC will allocate. General Information for 2025

Defaults

Defaults are of concern and **SHOULD NOT HAPPEN.** It is extremely frustrating and inconvenient for both the centre and non-offending teams. It can also impact points after each round. Teams who default with less than 24 hours' notice will be charged a fee of \$30. Teams who participate in Senior Premier grade (Thursdays) will forfeit 4 points for a default.

Good Sports

Tauranga Netball in association with Hewletts Night n Day, introduced the Good Sports initiative with a focus on great behaviours while participating, spectating and officiating the game of netball.

The objective of this initiative is to reduce the number of incidents where inappropriate verbal abuse is used as the normal way we communicate during games.

Any incidents of misconduct will be dealt with in line with our Zero Tolerance and Complaint Regulations. These can be found in our Regulations which are on the website.

Light & Court Hire

There are courts and lights available at Tauranga Netball Centre for teams who wish to practice each week. The cost is **\$150.00 (plus a \$30 key bond)** for the season which enables your team to train once a week for one and half hour duration throughout the netball season. To avoid disappointment, call the office today and make a booking.

First Aid

Teams must provide their own medical kit and have it courtside each week. Ice is available from the downstairs office. First Aid kits are available for purchase at very competitive prices.

Affiliated Clubs & Team Colours

It has become increasingly difficult to identify a club by their uniform as we have ended up with a duplication of teams wearing the same colour. Clubs feel very strongly about their club colours, as it is a part of their history and it is their identity. We will endeavour to do our very best to avoid further clashes with uniform colours.

New clubs/teams starting up must first seek approval and existing clubs/teams must also seek approval if they are considering changing the colour of their uniform.

Dress Code

Uniform Options – Players and Umpires

- 1. Alternative uniform options DO NOT apply to Open Premier Competition & College Premier 1-4 Grade Competition.
- 2. Any male players playing in competitions listed in a) will be allowed to wear approved shirts and shorts.
- 3. All teams must be recognisable as a team based on their playing uniform.
- 4. Umpires must be distinguishable from the teams.
- 5. All players in a team must wear matching bibs.
- 6. A new club, school, or team must submit colour image of their proposed uniform and bib for approval and registration. Once registered, no other team can wear the same uniform.

- 7. Teams wishing to purchase new uniforms must receive approval from TNC Management team prior to purchasing uniforms.
- 8. Uniforms must be 'appropriate'. As this is difficult to define, the intent is to prevent teams and umpires wearing uniforms that could be considered offensive or inappropriate. The TNC Management team will have the final decision on what is deemed 'appropriate'.

Chewing Gum

Please refrain from chewing gum in the court enclosure and while you are playing, and especially spitting it out. Rubbish bins are provided for this.

Unsupervised Children

Please ensure all children are satisfactorily supervised during any netball competition.

Children are not permitted to run inside the centre facility for safety reasons. Children are not permitted to be courtside in umpires run off for obvious safety reasons.

Volunteers
