Tauranga Netball
Service Award
Nomination Guidelines 2021

A Tauranga Netball Service Award recognises an individual who has demonstrated a positive and significant contribution of service to Tauranga Netball Centre (TNC), in one, some or all of the following areas:

Administration
Umpiring

Coaching
Playing

Managing
Volunteering

Pre-requisite for Nomination:

An individual must have completed a minimum of five (5) years of service to TNC and during this time has consistently upheld the TNC values and demonstrated a positive and significant contribution to TNC. This person is the Nominee.

Basis for Award:

The details supplied should be informative, accurate and fully detailed to ensure a full assessment of the nomination to be done. When assessing a nomination, consideration is given to:

- The level at which the contribution was made.
- The length of time over which the contribution was made.
- The quality of the contribution made.

Procedure for Nomination:

Nominations are to be made on the official nomination form (available from the TNC Office or from the TNC website (www.tauranganetball.co.nz), and can be made by any affiliated Member, Club/School, Life Member or Board Member. The person, club or school who provides the nomination is the Nominator.

Information supplied shall consist of:

- Personal Details relating to the nominee.
- Full details for positions held and years of service.
- Disclosure of any paid service.
- A statement provided by the Nominator outlining the basis for the nomination.

Nominations are to be submitted to the Tauranga Netball Awards Committee (2021 Tauranga Netball Centre Board will take up this role) (TNCAC), to be received no later than 5pm on Friday 5th November 2021. This nomination is to be marked “Confidential” and can be submitted as follows:

Consideration of Nomination:

All nominations are considered by the TNCAC to determine if the nomination is to be presented to the Tauranga Netball Board (TNCB). The Nominator will be advised of the outcome of the decision made by the TNCAC (this decision is not subject to appeal or review).

Unsuccessful Nominations:

The TNCAC gives careful and full consideration of each nomination, based on the information that is provided within the nomination form. Nominations can be re-submitted in future years and will need to include additional and/or more details to further support the nomination.
