1. BOARD MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT

The Board is committed to teamwork and effective decision-making. Towards this end board members will:

- 1. Accept the constitutional responsibilities which come with being a Board Member.
- 2. Support Tauranga Netball philosophy, aims, objectives and policy, working for the common good of netball at this Centre.
- 3. Allocate sufficient time before coming to meetings to ensure adequate preparation.
- 4. Be punctual and focussed during the meeting.
- 5. Endeavour to represent the broader interest of members and/or stakeholders.
- 6. Refrain from trying to influence other board members outside of board meetings that might limit free and open discussions at meetings.
