4. DISCLOSURE OF INTERESTS

OVERALL RESPONSIBILITY

DAY TO DAY OPERATION

BOARD CHAIRPERSON

- 1. All members of the TNC Board must disclose any potential or actual conflict of interest in any issue affecting Tauranga Netball Centre's contracts, proposed contracts, arrangements, or dealings.
- 2. Members conflicts of interest must be declared and entered into the *Disclosure* of *Interests register*:
 - prior to the first meeting of the Board following the election of officers and
 - at the commencement of each meeting.
- 3. Where a member has a conflict of interest that member shall not initiate or take part in any discussion on that topic, unless by unanimous agreement by all other members.
- 4. A Board Member disclosing an interest shall not vote in respect of the matter in which that Board Member has an interest.
- 5. Where multiple board members have disclosed an interest and thus there are insufficient members who can vote, the Board may pass a majority resolution that it is in the best interests of TNC to proceed with all members speaking and voting on the motion.
- 6. When a Board Member receives written notification of an **undisclosed** potential or actual conflict of interest the Board Chairperson will form a committee with another chosen Board member. If the concern, relates to the Board Chairman then two other Board Members will be appointed as a committee by the Board.

The committee will

- (i) Contact the Board Member involved, disclose the concern and arrange to meet and discuss.
- (ii) Undertake any other enquiries the committee thinks appropriate regarding the matter and report the findings back to the Board Member.
- (iii) Report to the Board (via email, teleconference, or meeting) on the matter and the committee's decision and actions steps. The decision of the conflicts committee is final.
- (iv) Steps to be taken if the conflicts committee decide there is a potential or actual conflict might include the following:

- (a) Require the Board Member to be absent from any Board or other Tauranga Netball Centre meeting, or relevant part of the meeting and to adhere to this procedure.
- (b) In a case of intentional or reckless involvement in the conflict matter, the termination of the Board Member from the Board under the TNC Constitution.
